Bring your entire class!

What are CLASS VISITS?

Instructors bring their entire class to the Campus Writing Center, usually for one hour, to work in small groups with our highly-trained writing & reading tutors.

Here's how it works....

Students, tutors, and the instructor meet in the Writing Center (L-113), and the class is divided into 7 or 8 small groups of 3-4 students each.

- Students receive information about the Writing Center's services.
- The instructor then discusses with students and tutors the assignment that they will be working on. That way, we're all on the same page before getting started.

We can help your students at ANY stage of the writing process, such as:

- Analyzing the assignment / prompt
- Brainstorming and outlining
- Conducting research
- Formulating an argument or thesis
- Using MLA and APA citation
- Revising a previous draft



Easy to set up...

1. E-mail us at cwc@qcc.cuny.edu and let us know which date(s) and time(s) you would like to bring your class.
2. A few days before your scheduled visit, e-mail us a copy of the assignment your students will be working on.
3. After getting a confirmation e-mail, tell your students to meet at the Campus Writing Center instead of the classroom.
